



Welcome to the OPC Information CD

Installation of the CD.

The OPC Information CD will automatically load the main function screen with the button selections as described below, provided the machine has the AUTORUN function turned on. This function can be turned on in the control panel selections.

(See the Microsoft Windows documentation for the details).

Otherwise, the CD can be run by using the RUN selection from the Microsoft START menu. Select RUN, Browse the CD to locate the application program **StartOPC** on the main directory of the OPC Information CD. Select this program, make sure the program named **StartOPC** is in the RUN window and click OK.

To access the information on this CD, a series of buttons are provided. Each performs a specific function for viewing the CD contents.



Use your mouse to click on the desired information display function. As the mouse goes over a button, a short description of the button function is displayed. The 4 buttons and their functions are:
